#### 2016-17 Activities:


- Engaged faculty and staff in grant writing

Of the funded awards, 27.5% were federal, 12.5 % were state, 57.5 % private and 2.5% PASSHE; and 37.5% were for service, 55% were for instruction, and 7.5% were for research.


- Conducted a faculty workshop on September 11, 20, and 28, 2016.

- Streamlined processes and documented procedures to improve the effectiveness and efficiency of pre- and post-award processes.




