




10. Go to D2L content and select an existing module to include the new lesson. After selecting your module, click the Add Activities button and select External Learning Tools.

12. Once selected, the lesson should automatically be inserted into your content module.


13. At this point you will need to set the grading method by clicking on the name of your lesson in your content. See sample below.

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1. In SoftChalk Create \rightarrow Package Lesson...

2. In the packaging/Student Options select the Standard zip and LMS with SCORM 1.2 radio buttons. You also have a choice of single or unlimited attempts at the quiz questions.
